



Vinson Youth Football League Conduct & Expectations

- Sideline coaching from parents and others is not permitted and will be addressed.
- Any and all conflicting opinions, statements, etc. must be addressed with the coach after practices, games, and/or in absence all children and spectators.
- Foul language, aggressive behavior and/or threats of any type will not be tolerated and will result in disciplinary action by Vinson Youth Football League Executive Board.
- Screaming, degrading, belittling of cheerleader, majorettes or players is forbidden and will not be tolerated from anyone!
- Unsportsmanlike conduct is unacceptable. This includes but is not limited to:
 - Fighting or any conduct intended to provoke a fight
 - Profanity from fans and/or spectators towards official, a coach or any person officially involved with the activities of the game or games.

All incidents will be officially reported to the VYFL President and the TSYFL Commissioner in accordance with the WVSSAC Activities Commission.

- Coaches, majorettes, players, cheerleaders, league representatives and all others associated with this youth program must adhere to Tri-State Youth Football League ideals and purposes, or else forfeit their right to participate.
- All majorettes, cheerleaders, and players must have one parent volunteer to work concession, or chain at some point during the season.
- Unexcused absences of football practice may affect the player's game playing time.
- Smoking is not permitted inside field fence or in immediate practice area.
